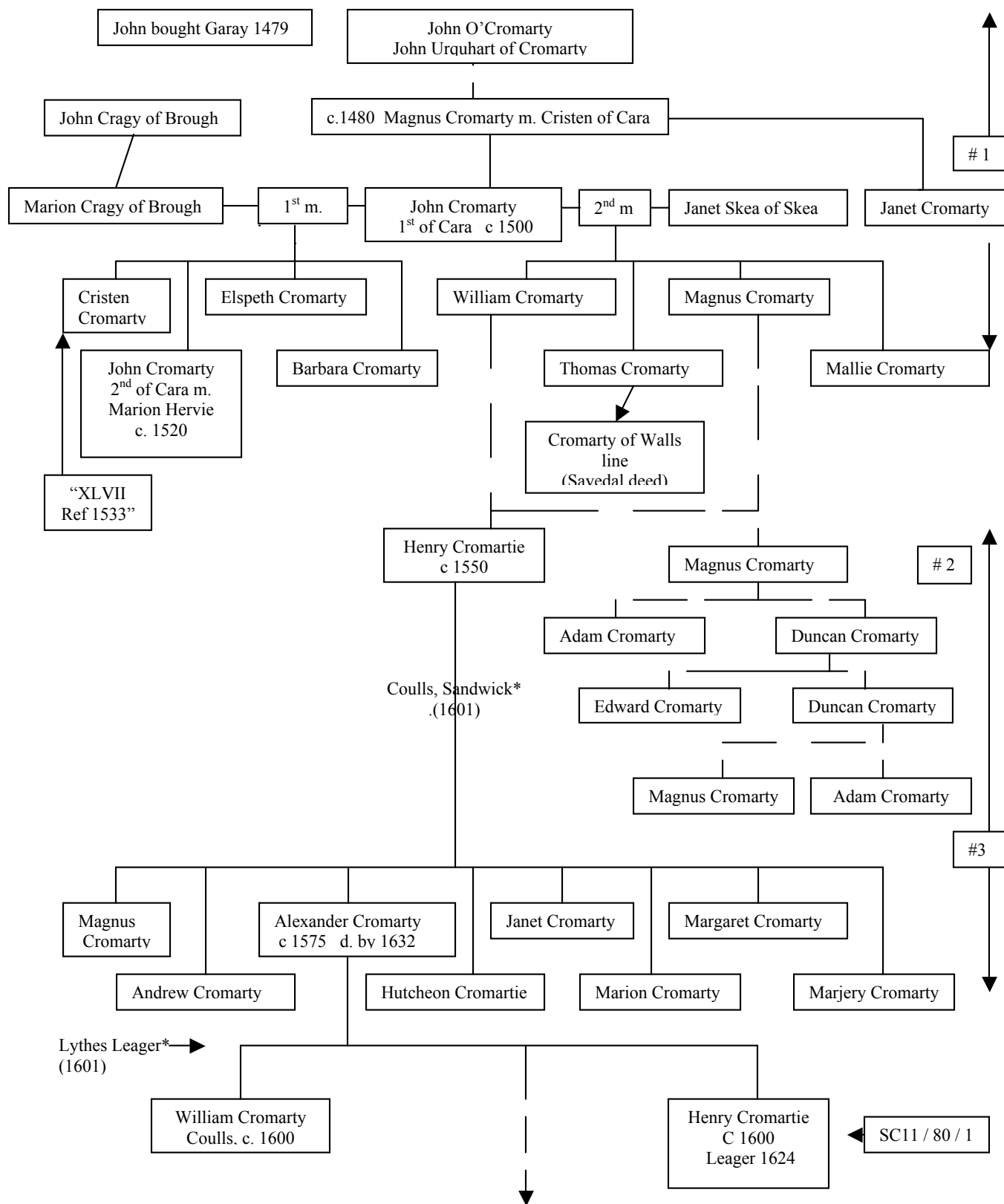

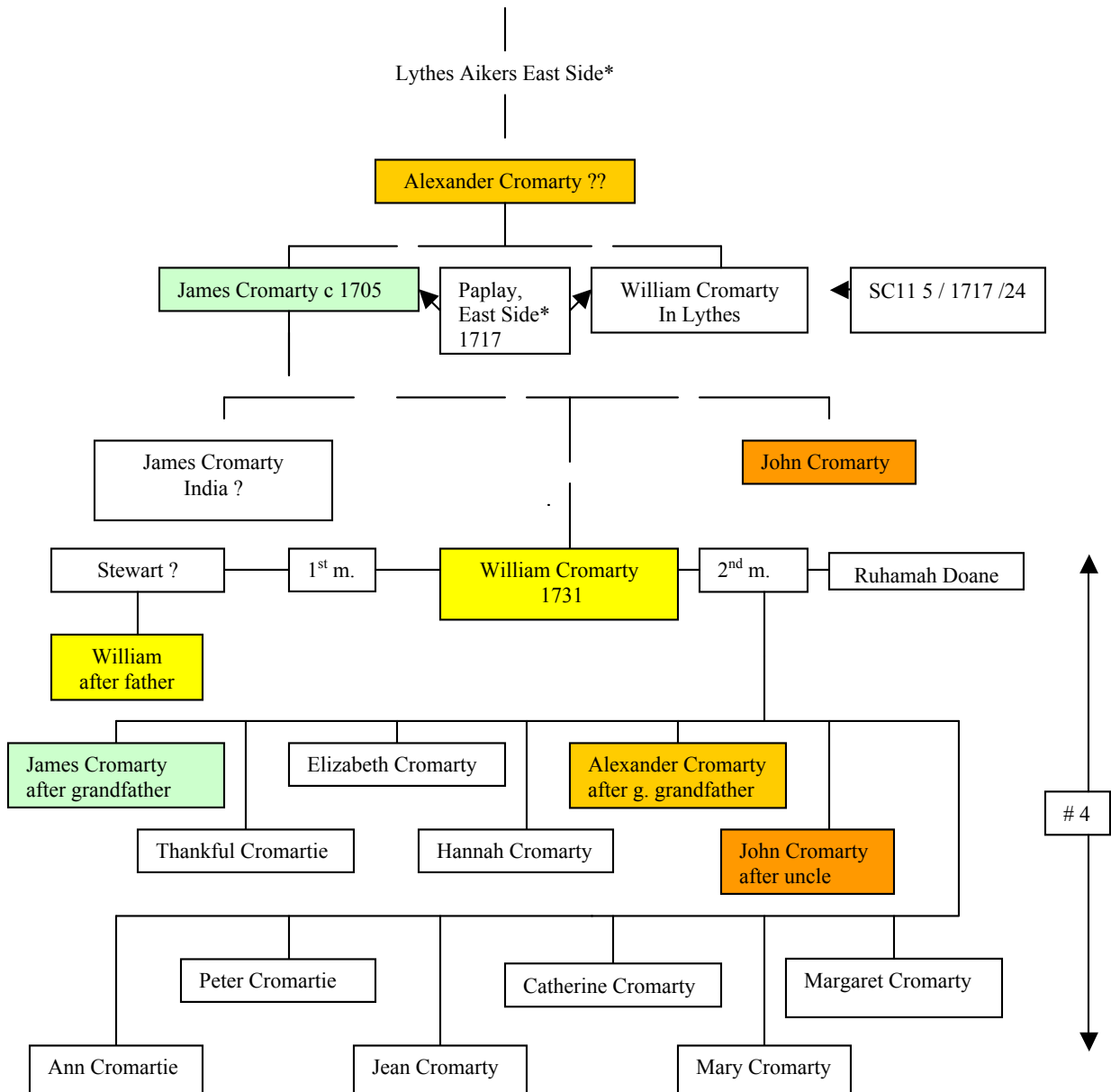

### Notes:

In Orkney the naming of children, especially the order in which they are named plays a vital part in connecting the family backward: first son after his father, second son after his grand father, third son after his great grand father, fourth son after his uncle. Names were frequently associated with where the person lived, i.e. John Urquhart of Cromarty and could be shortened to John O'Cromarty.

Some place names in the chart are designated with an \* to assist readers that aren't familiar with Scotland geography names. Boxed notations such as SC11/5/1632/ and #1 are references found in the Orkney Archives. The numbered notations are explained below.
